

POLICY: ON YOUTH PRESENCE AT CONVENTION

Each Congregation of the Diocese of Eau Claire may have up to two youth members as an official youth delegation to the Annual Diocesan Convention. Youth Delegates are defined as:

1. Up to age sixteen.
2. Having been elected by peers to represent the opinion and interests of youth members of that Congregation.
3. Having had the experience of attending at least one Vestry meeting prior to Convention.

Their duties are to:

1. Participate in Convention activities, including worship services, discussion groups, writing and presenting proposals, and organized youth fellowship during Convention.
2. Be present on the floor for the observation of the decision-making process,
3. Present a verbal report to the youth members of their own Congregation within 30 days following Convention.
