"Moneys accepted for memorials, designated or undesignated, shall be administered and disbursed committee on memorials consisting of the Rector or Vicar and four members of the Parish or Mission, at two of whom shall be members of the Vestry, to be named annually by the Rector or Vicar. Any pewishing to install a memorial of any kind in the church must receive approval of this committee prior to installation of said memorial. The committee on memorials shall act as a council of advice on memorials shall have available at list of suitable things needed in the parish or Mission. The committee on memorials regularly report to the Annual Meeting of the Parish or Mission and, before disbursing any funct placing any memorial in a church or church building, shall receive the permission of the Vestry for disbursement or placement. The term "memorials" shall not include any funds left or provision mad devise, legacy, or bequest. Such undesignated funds shall be administered in accordance with the Canc General Financial Regulations. Designated memorial funds shall be used only for the purpose specified by donor."
